**Annual Popcorn Sale** Each year members of Troop 299 have the chance to earn money for summer camp and other scout related expenses. The annual Boy Scout popcorn sale held in the fall is an opportunity to do just that. This fundraiser is totally voluntary and as a result only the scouts participating will benefit from this opportunity. The amount earned will depend directly on how much effort is applied. The Dan Beard Council also offers different prizes depending on the amount of sales.

Order forms were distributed at the October 7<sup>th</sup> Troop meeting. Order forms will be collected at the October 21<sup>st</sup> and October 28<sup>th</sup> Troop meetings. Popcorn will be available for pick-up November 22<sup>nd</sup>. **Money for the popcorn is due when you deliver the popcorn** and will be collected at the December 2<sup>nd</sup> and December 9<sup>th</sup> Troop meetings.

**The Commission** on the popcorn sales is about 1/3 of the cost of the popcorn. The commission earned from each popcorn item will be held in the troop treasury in the name of the Scout who sold the popcorn. The scout is encouraged to save the commission for larger expenses like summer camp or high adventure camp. If the Scout leaves the Troop before using his commission, the commission will be forfeited to the Troop. Besides commission, the Scout can earn different types of prizes. One of the prizes offered are "Scout Bucks." The Troop allows the Scout to deposit these bucks into their commission fund.

This year, Kevin K, is serving as the Troop's chairperson for the popcorn sale.

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RECHARTER TIME- It's that time of year that we renew the Charter between our Troop and the Boy Scouts. The cost per Scout or Adult volunteer is \$11.75 for membership plus \$12.00 for Boy's Life Magazine. The membership fee includes addition medical insurance for the members. That insurance covers additional expenses if an accident occurred during a Scouting event. Lisa will be collecting the fees on October 28, November 11 and 25.
